

UNESCO Prize for

Girls' and Women's Education

Call for nominations 2024

**Deadline: 24 May 2024**

The UNESCO Prize for Girls' and Women's Education honors outstanding and innovative practices advancing **girls' and women's education**, and in turn, improving the quality of their lives. Established in 2015, it is funded by the Government of the People's Republic of China and consists of two US \$50,000 awards to help further the work of laureates in this field. The Prize directly contributes to Sustainable Development Goals 4 and 5.

## Who can nominate?

Governments of UNESCO Member States via their Permanent Delegations to UNESCO, and non-governmental organizations in official partnership with UNESCO can make up to 3 nominations. Self-nominations are not accepted.

## Who can be nominated?

Individuals, institutions or organizations advancing girls' and women's education through an established and ongoing project or programme which has been running for at least 2 years. Visit the Prize's website for more details.

## How to nominate?

Nominations must be submitted in English or French by a UNESCO Member State or an NGO in official partnership with UNESCO, via an online platform, no later than 24 May 2024 (midnight, Paris time). Contact us for more information.
